

SkyNet Mac MDM [Remote Management] Bypass

Step-by-Step Service Guide

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* Prerequisites: Reinstall macOS

Before proceeding, format your drive as 'Macintosh HD' during macOS reinstall.

This helps avoid system errors during activation.

** Post-Installation Preparation

1. Shutdown Device

On the setup (Hello) screen, press and hold the Power button to turn off your Mac.

2. Enter Recovery Mode

Apple Silicon (M1/M2/M3): Press and hold the Power button until 'Options' appears.

Intel Mac: Press and hold Command (CMD) + R at startup.

* Connect and Prepare Activation

3. Connect to WiFi

Ensure your Mac is connected to the internet for activation.

4. Open Safari in Recovery Mode

Go to 'Utilities > Safari'.

5. Run the Script

Choose your compatible script based on:

* T2 Chip or

* M-Series (M1/M2/M3)

Open Terminal (Utilities > Terminal).

Paste the command (CMD + V), then press ENTER to execute.

Wait for the process to complete.

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Once done, Reboot your Mac.

* User Setup & Cleanup

6. Initial Login

Sign in with the following:

Username: Apple

Password: 1234

7. Skip Initial Setup

Skip:

- Apple ID
- Siri
- Touch ID
- Location Services

Disable all telemetry.

8. Create Your Administrator Account

Go to: System Settings > Users & Groups

Click the + (plus) to create your personal admin account.

9. Switch to Your Account

Log out of the Apple account.

Log in using your newly created account.

10. Delete the Temporary Apple Profile

Return to Users & Groups:

- Click the [lock] and authenticate.
- Select the Apple user.

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- Click the - (minus) to delete.
- Choose 'Delete the home folder.'

*** Done! Your Mac is now ready for use.**
